

There are currently 2164 farmers waiting for ROPS in 48 states.

The Minnesota ROPS Rebate Program continues to be quite a success story. With continued funding through the Minnesota Department of Agriculture there are no longer any farmers waiting to install a ROPS on their tractors, joining New York as the only states that have no farmers waiting to proceed through the program.

The National Farm Medicine Center in Marshfield, Wisconsin recently secured \$40,000 of funding for ROPS rebates. This funding will help approximately 35 farmers in Wisconsin to install rollbars on their unequipped tractors.
